The caretaker will report to the studio owner.

Job Overview

The caretaker does a weekly deep cleaning of the studio which takes approximately 2 hours. There is a checklist to follow. You can choose your time for the deep cleaning from available studio times but you must keep the same schedule from week to week. The caretaker also vacuums the mat and does a quick “pick up” on the days they are at the studio for classes. Generally helps keep the space clean and tidy.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Cleans all mats
- Vacuums big purple mat (Persephone) and all rugs
- Wipes surfaces
- Throws away trash and replaces trash bags
- Shop vac the cement floor and mop
- Clean bathrooms
- Water plants
- Collect lost and found items
- Spray fabrics
- Communicate any damage of equipment or potentially unsafe situations

*This is not a comprehensive list but is meant to give you an idea of what the job entails.

Qualifications

There are no educational or experience requirements for this position, however, candidates must be dependable, take care in the details, be able to reach low, high, and be able to lift 10 lbs.
